Public-Private Partnership to Fight Terrorism

The 26/11 terror attack on Mumbai has served at least one purpose. It opened up the eyes of the Indian citizenry to the naked reality that terror is a fact of life, and it can strike anyone, anything, anytime, anywhere.

True, government agencies are primarily responsible for containing terrorism. But, given the nature and magnitude of terrorist threat that is constantly evolving, government by itself cannot handle the menace successfully. A large number of possible terror targets are owned or managed by the private sector. Not even the governments of advanced countries - not to speak of a developing nation like India - possess sufficient human, physical, intellectual and technological resources to ensure the protection of them all. The most sensible way of going about preventing and combating terrorism, and managing the fall-outs of terror attacks, is for the private sector organisations, voluntary institutions, NGOs and the entire civil society to join forces with government agencies. Besides critical infrastructures and security establishments, soft targets such as major financial centres, tourist spots, historical monuments, heritage sites, places of worship, shopping malls, educational institutions, sports complexes, auditoriums, factories, transport and communication hubs and other crowded areas must be protected through voluntary co-operation, founded upon the principles of partnership and mutual trust.

The business community must look at security as an 'investment,' rather than as a 'cost'. Protecting an infrastructure means two things. First, the safety and prosperity of the business venture; and second, a longer service life for the infrastructure itself.

There is an urgent need for defining which type of information the government can share with private stakeholders. This will enable them to play an important role in preventing terror attacks, and not just help in managing the crisis left behind by the perpetrators. For this purpose, it is essential to promote a common ground and strive to bridge the two sectors which, after all, have different priorities before them.
